

MLC HAWAIIAN WITH PPE

Items noted as PPE must be worn while skiing, snowboarding, teaching, doing set up, shoveling and in general when working outside or in hazard areas when directed by supervisor. This uniform apparel is appropriate during warm, sunny weather conditions. Check with your supervisor for a loaner Hawaiian shirt. Personal Hawaiian shirts are considered a uniform item when worn with a name tag and while on duty. Hawaiian shirt must be worn with long sleeve under garment (PPE) to protect lower arms.

Helmet (PPE)

Eye Protection (PPE) - goggles or sunglasses

Shirt buttoned above the name tag

Name tag worn opposite side of logo

First name, last name or last initial, pronouns (optional), and title. Nicknames are OK - "call names" are not OK.

Sunscreen (PPE)

On sunny days be sure to apply sunscreen

Gloves or Mittens (PPE)

Gloves/Mittens even on warm days are required

Long Sleeves (PPE)

Long sleeves under garment required

Appropriately fit black pants

Company supplied or personal black pants must fit as shown
Not overly baggy or overly tight

Appropriate cuff length

Pant cuffs should not drag on the ground or be rolled up above the top of the boots

Ski, snowboard, snow boots/shoes

Ski or Snowboard boots when teaching, snow boots when appropriate, closed toe shoes at all times. Snow chains or anti-slip attachments recommended
