

MLC RAIN GEAR WITH PPE

Items noted as PPE must be worn while skiing, snowboarding, teaching, doing set up, shoveling and in general when working outside or in hazard areas when directed by supervisor. This uniform apparel is appropriate when the forecast calls for rain or the current conditions are raining and/or temperatures hovering at or above 32 degrees F.

Eye Protection (PPE) - goggles or sunglasses

Helmet (PPE)

Garment zipped up above the logo

No Name tag required

To prevent damage to the rain gear, no name tag required

Gloves or Mittens (PPE)

Appropriately fitted garment

Must not be over or under sized

Appropriately fitted pants

Not overly baggy or overly tight

Appropriate cuff length

Pant cuffs should not drag on the ground or be rolled up above the top of the boots

Ski, snowboard, snow boots/shoes

Ski or Snowboard boots when teaching, snow boots when appropriate, closed toe shoes at all times. Snow chains or anti-slip attachments recommended
